Saturday 6th February 2016

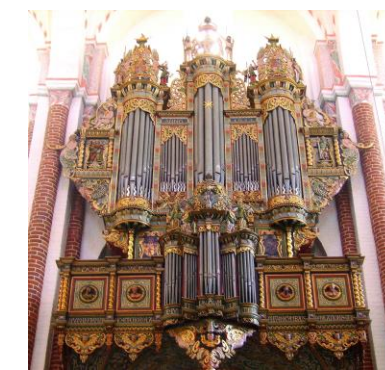
The Annual Society Lunch at Corinthian Restaurant, Goldsmith Street.

Saturday 18th June 2016

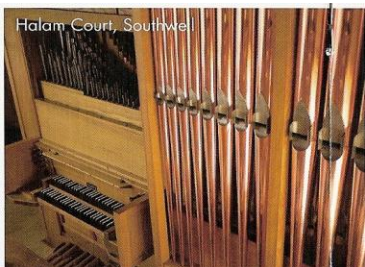
The President’s Evening

Fun, music and refreshments at Halam Court.

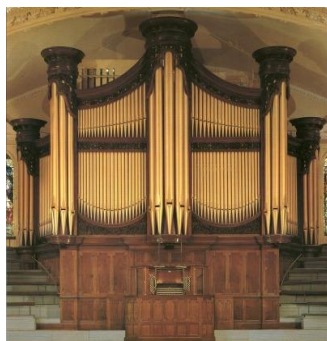
Monday 18th July 2016
