Organist/Pianist for St. Peter's Ravenshead



We are looking for a gifted musician with both skill and a Christian faith who will enthusiastically accompany two services every Sunday morning (working from 9.15am-12.30pm approximately). They would need to be very comfortable with traditional church organ music and in sympathy with contemporary worship. They would work under the direction of the choir master for our more traditional 9.30am service and support a small music group at the later informal 11.15am service. A brief practice with the music group would be necessary between the services.

Ravenshead PCC believes that music is very important to worship. It enhances our connection with God and in our worship God is made manifest. In the past St. Peter's has enjoyed a rich variety of music and we look forward to music playing a full part in our worship in the future, as we emerge from the restrictions of the pandemic. We have been well-served in recent times by some very able volunteers and by our organist who sadly died at the end of 2020.

Feedback suggests that many church members appreciate a breadth of styles of music, which includes classic hymns, sung aspects of the Eucharist, choir anthems, modern hymns, contemporary worship songs, as well as the occasional Taizé chant.

We hope that in due course a choir will return to the earlier service. Therefore, there might also be the opportunity for additional work rehearsing with the choir midweek (how frequently is yet to be determined, as the choir returns).
